Please do not submit sensitive clinical, diagnostic, or emergency information through the website.

How We Use Website Information

Information submitted through our website is used solely to:

- Respond to your inquiry
- Manage our therapy waitlist
- Determine availability and service fit
- Contact you regarding next steps

We do not sell, rent, or use website-submitted information for marketing or advertising purposes.

Washington My Health My Data Act Disclosure

Under Washington law, some information submitted through this website may be considered “consumer health data.” We collect only the minimum information necessary to respond to your request.

We do not share consumer health data with third parties except as permitted or required by law or as necessary to operate our website securely.

Security of Information

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect information submitted through our website. Website forms are encrypted, and access is restricted to authorized personnel.

No method of electronic transmission is completely secure. We encourage you to limit the information you submit to what is necessary.

Third-Party Website Services
